MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB

To provide high-quality medical care and treatment to clients, particularly survivors of torture, in line with ACTV policies, professional standards, and legal and ethical guidelines.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Examine, counsel, and provide appropriate medical treatment to survivors of torture and other clients.
- 2. Work collaboratively with other health professionals and staff at the clinic to ensure comprehensive patient care.
- 3. Refer clients to appropriate specialists and follow up on referred cases to track treatment progress.
- 4. Prepare detailed medical reports for submission to the Uganda Human Rights Commission and Courts of Law.
- 5. Serve as an expert medical witness in court proceedings where necessary.
- 6. Participate in scheduled outreach activities, including visits to detention centers.
- 7. Contribute to planning and budgeting processes for the Medical Unit in accordance with ACTV guidelines.
- 8. Support proposal development and other fundraising initiatives as needed.
- 9. Produce timely and accurate periodic medical reports.
- 10. Perform any other duties as and when assigned to by the supervisor directly or indirectly.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

- Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBChB) from a recognized institution.
- Registered with the Uganda Medical and Dental Practitioners Council.

- A minimum of 2 years' post-internship clinical experience.
- Experience working with vulnerable populations preferably in an NGO setting, including survivors of trauma or torture, is an added advantage.
- Excellent communication, teamwork, and report writing skills.
